I refer to the above details. An appeal has been made to the Secretary of State against the decision of Derbyshire Dales District Council to refuse to grant Listed Building Consent.

The appeal will be determined on the basis of written representations. The procedure to be followed is set out in Part 2 of the Town and Country Planning (Appeals) (Written Representations Procedure) (England) Regulations 2009.

We have forwarded all the representations made to us on the application to the Planning Inspectorate and the appellant. These will be considered by the Inspector when determining the appeal.

Please note that any representations you submit to the Planning Inspectorate will be copied to the appellant and this local planning authority and will be considered by the Inspector when determining the appeal.

The appeal documentation, including copies of representations received, will be published on the Derbyshire Dales District Council website. Information provided in your representations will be published. This may include your name and address, but personal telephone numbers, email addresses and signatures of individuals will be removed.

The appeal documents are also available for inspection at the Council's offices during normal office hours.

The Council's statement will be available for inspection in the near future. If you wish to inspect any of the appeal documentation you should telephone in advance; particularly to avoid a wasted journey in event of the Council's statement not being complete.
